### GRADING

**1. Assigned reading (25 %)** On the final exam there will be a question asking students to state the percentage of the assigned reading that they have read with reasonable care by the due date of the final exam.

**2. Exams (50 %)** Students will take two essay exams in this course (take home). The exams will test comprehension and critical grasp of lectures and all assigned readings.

**3. Research paper (25 %)** Students will write a research paper related to a topic treated in this course. Paper topics will be chosen in consultation with the professor. Papers should (i) have a clear thesis in the first paragraph, (ii) exhibit thoughtful theological analysis, (iii) be written in clear, readable English (please use a proofreader), (iv) be between 12-15 pages in length, Times New Roman, 12 point font, double spaced.
